THREE (3) TYPES OF SUPERVISION**



STANDARD

ELECTRONIC MONITORING (GPS)

ALCOHOL MONITORING

STANDARD - Defendant is required to report to PTS via phone or in person at a Court-ordered frequency. If no frequency is noted on the court order, defendant will be required to report by phone (2) times per week. The Judge may require special conditions, e.g., random drug testing, drug evaluation, curfew, no contact or feet restriction w/victim(s), specific individual(s), location or co-defendant(s).

Example Court Order (CO) Narrative: Pretrial Services STANDARD supervision (plus Special Conditions- SC)

ELECTRONIC MONITORING (Also referred to as GPS MONITOR / ELMO) - Fee Imposed

GPS – **G**lobal **P**ositioning **S**ystems accurately track a defendant's position and daily movement

LEVELS (1) or (2) or OPEN SCHEDULE are always supervised via **Electronic Monitoring GPS.**

- **LEVEL 1 - House Arrest (most restrictive)** - defendants shall remain confined to their approved residence twenty-four (24) hours per day. **The only exception shall be for medical emergencies. PRE-APPROVAL IS NEEDED** for medical appointments, meetings with assigned attorneys or Pretrial Services staff, Court hearings or Court ordered programs (not permitted to work or attend school). The Judge may require special conditions, e.g., random drug testing, drug evaluation, no contact or feet restriction with the victim(s), specific individual(s), location or co-defendant(s).

Example CO Narrative: Pretrial Services LEVEL 1 GPS Monitor (plus SC)

OR

- **LEVEL 2 - House Arrest** - defendants shall remain confined to their approved residence twenty-four (24) hours per day. **The only exception shall be for medical emergencies. PRE-APPROVAL IS NEEDED** for medical appointments, meetings with assigned attorneys or Pretrial Services staff, Court hearings or Court ordered programs, lawful employment or maximum twenty (20) hours per week for job search, and educational purposes. Defendants may also receive a combined total of up to eight (8) hours (including travel time) per week to attend religious services, for personal shopping, and laundry services (if needed). The Judge may require special conditions, e.g., random drug testing, drug evaluation, curfew, no contact or feet restriction with the victim(s), specific individual(s), location or co-defendant(s).

Example CO Narrative: Pretrial Services LEVEL 2 GPS Monitor (plus SC)

OR

- **CURFEW** - defendants are **PERMITTED TO LEAVE THEIR RESIDENCE WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL** from or notification to **PRETRIAL SERVICES (PTS) DURING THE SPECIFIED TIMES**. The curfew can be monitored via **GPS**, must have a beginning and end time, and is typically used when the Court is chiefly concerned with the defendant being home at a designated time. The Judge may require special conditions, e.g., random drug testing, drug evaluation, no contact or feet restriction with the victim(s), specific individual(s), location or co-defendant(s).

Example CO Narrative: Pretrial Services GPS Monitor with Curfew (plus SC)

OR

- **OPEN SCHEDULE (Without Schedule Restrictions)** - defendants are **PERMITTED TO LEAVE THEIR RESIDENCE WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL** from or notification to **PTS AT ANY TIME**. This type is monitored via **GPS** only and is typically used when the Court is chiefly concerned with the defendant remaining a certain distance from an individual, victim(s), co-defendant or a specific location and not so much with the defendant's schedule. The Judge may require special conditions, e.g., random drug testing, drug evaluation, curfew, no contact or feet restriction with the victim(s), specific individual(s), location or co-defendant(s).

**Example CO Narrative: Pretrial Services GPS Monitor with Open Schedule (plus SC)
Pretrial Services GPS Monitor Open Schedule with Curfew (plus SC)**

NOTE: No such condition as: **LEVEL 1, 2 without the Monitor** or **LEVEL 1, 2 STANDARD** or **STANDARD with Open Schedule** or **LEVEL 1, 2 with Open Schedule**
If Court order includes any language about **LEVELS** or **ELECTRONIC MONITORING, GPS, MONITOR,** defendant will be subject to **House Arrest,** specifically **LEVEL 2,** unless otherwise noted.

ALCOHOL MONITORING - Fee Imposed

- **TAD** - **T**ransdermal **A**lcohol **D**etection device – monitors alcohol use through a transmitter attached to the defendant's ankle.

Example CO Narrative: Pretrial Services Alcohol Monitoring TAD (plus SC)

Pretrial Services Alcohol Monitoring TAD, Standard or GPS Monitor (plus SC)

Note:

- Monitoring fees are \$5.00 per day unless specifically waived on the Court order or the defendant is deemed indigent or represented by the Public Defender's Office. Defendants that have private attorneys are required to pay the fees.
